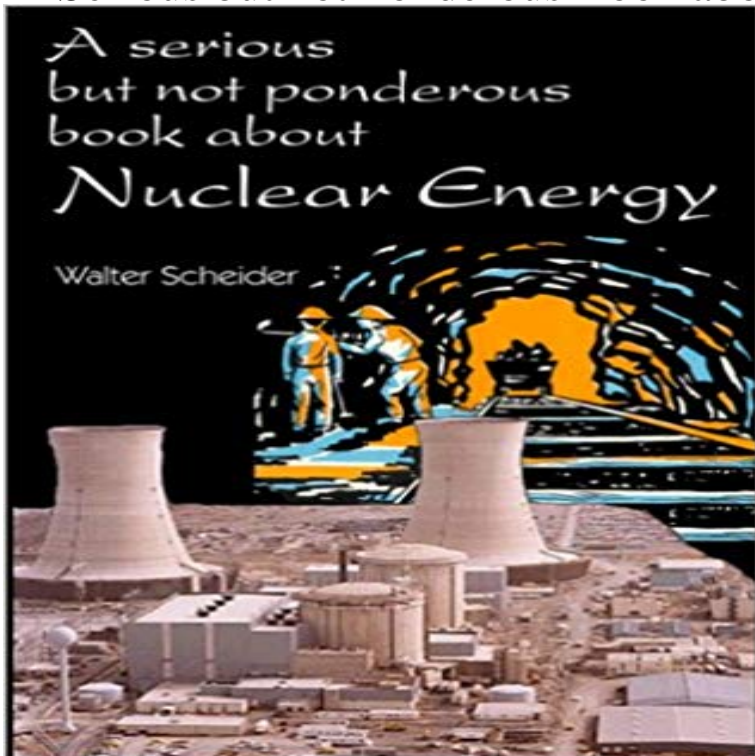


A Serious but not Ponderous Book about Nuclear Energy
