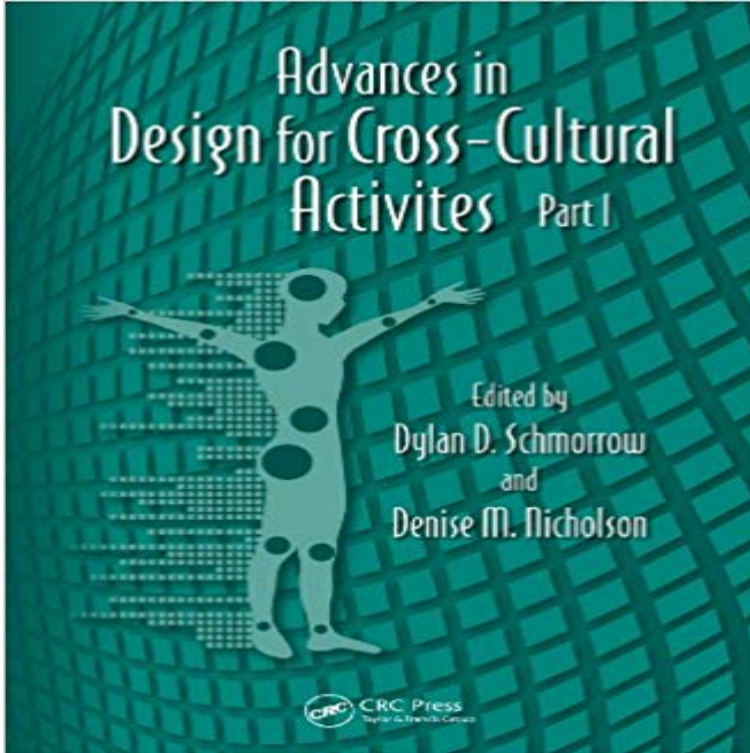


Advances in Design for Cross-Cultural Activities Part I (Advances in Human Factors and Ergonomics Series)
