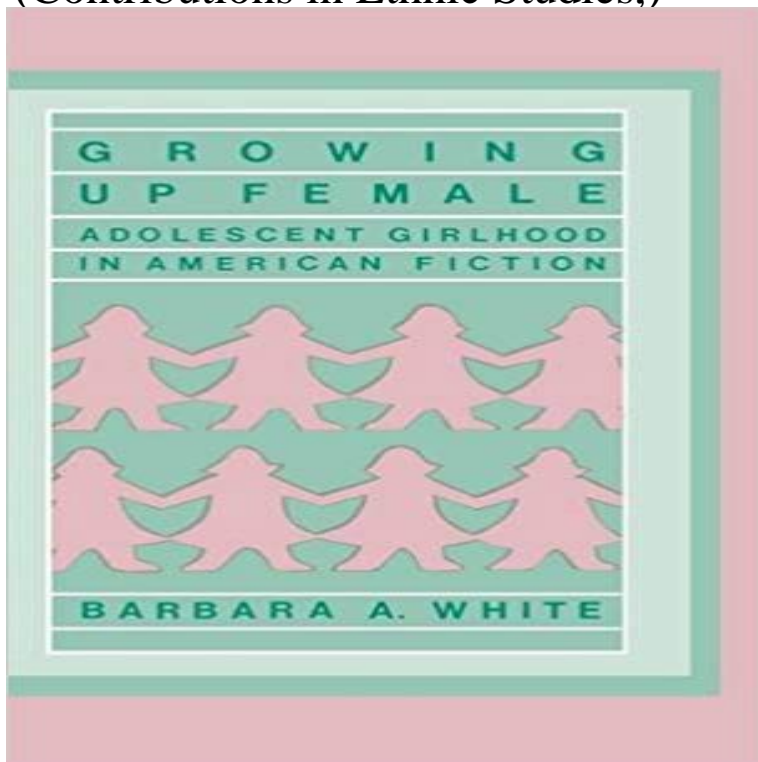


## Growing Up Female: Adolescent Girlhood in American Fiction (Contributions in Ethnic Studies,)
