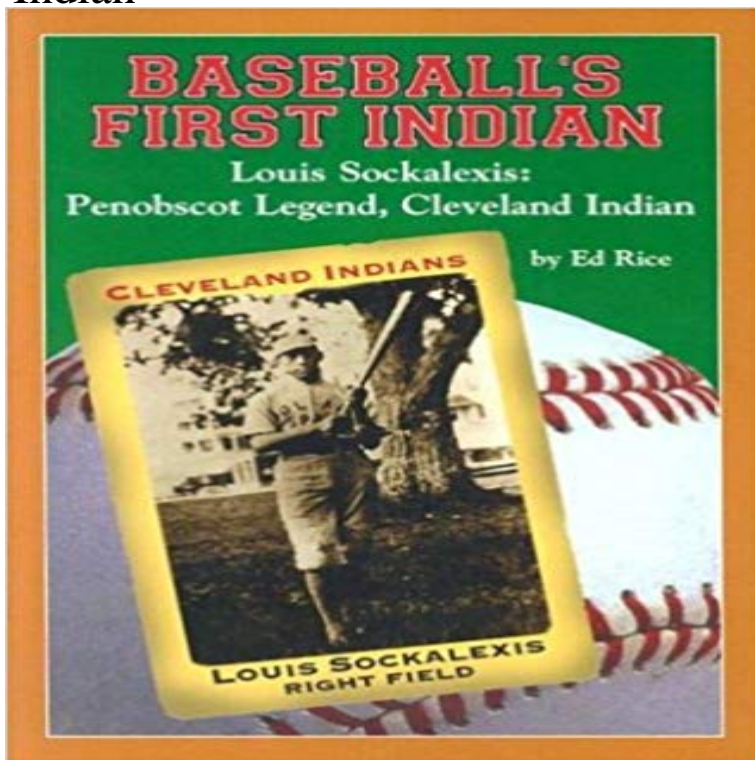


Baseballs First Indian, Louis Sockalexis: Penobscot Legend, Cleveland Indian



Born in 1871 on Maines Penobscot Indian reservation and nephew of a chief, Louis Sockalexis became professional baseballs first American Indian player. Ultimately, his prowess on the diamond inspired the nickname Cleveland's baseball team carries today.
