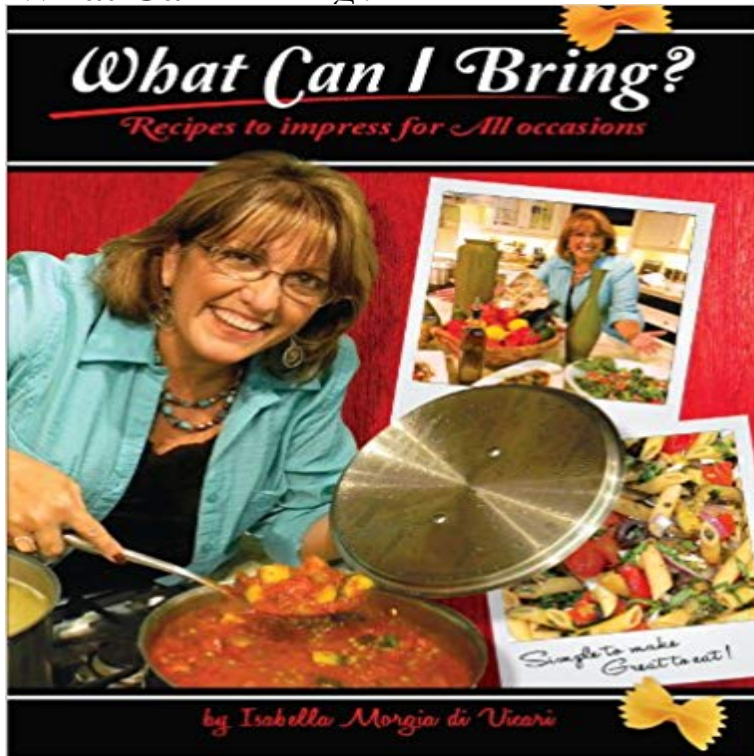


What Can I Bring?
