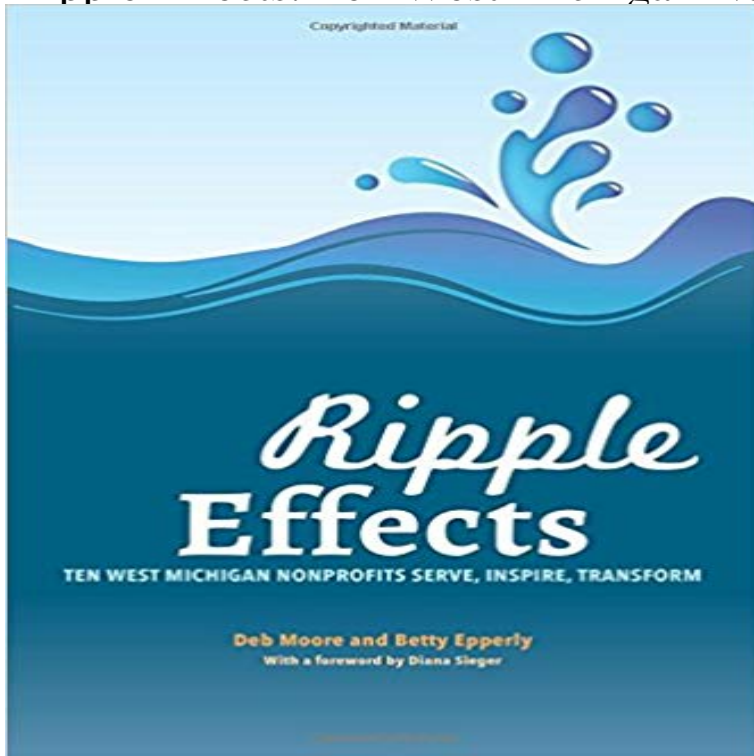


Ripple Effects: Ten West Michigan Nonprofits Serve, Inspire, Transform
