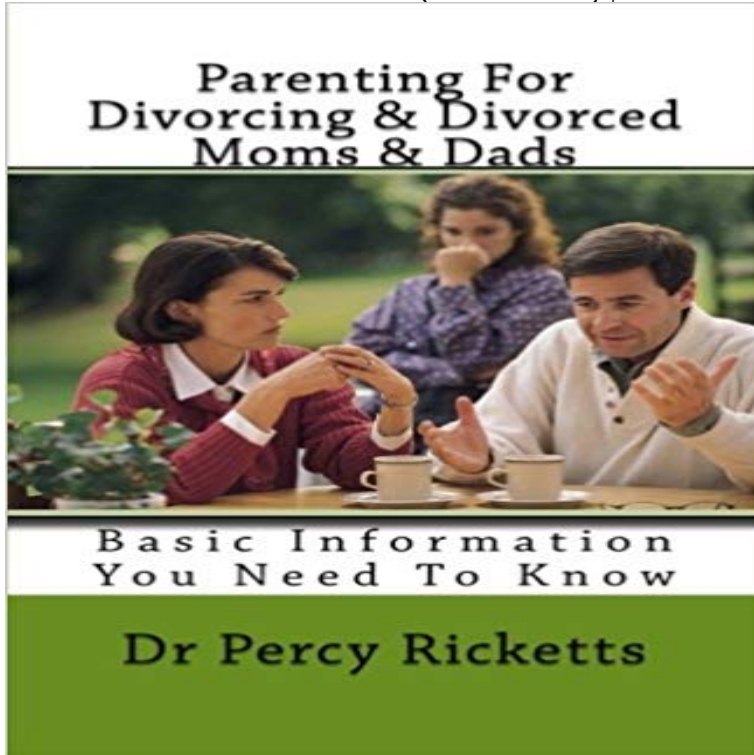


Parenting For Divorcing & Divorced Moms & Dads: Basic Information You Need To Know (Parenting for divorce) (Volume 3)
