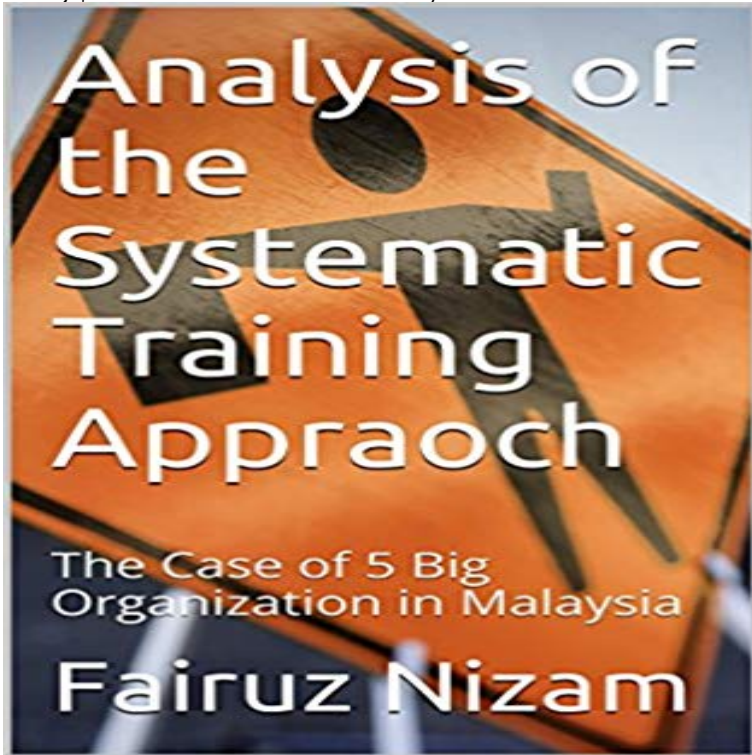


Analysis of the Systematic Training Approach: The Case of 5 Big Organization in Malaysia
