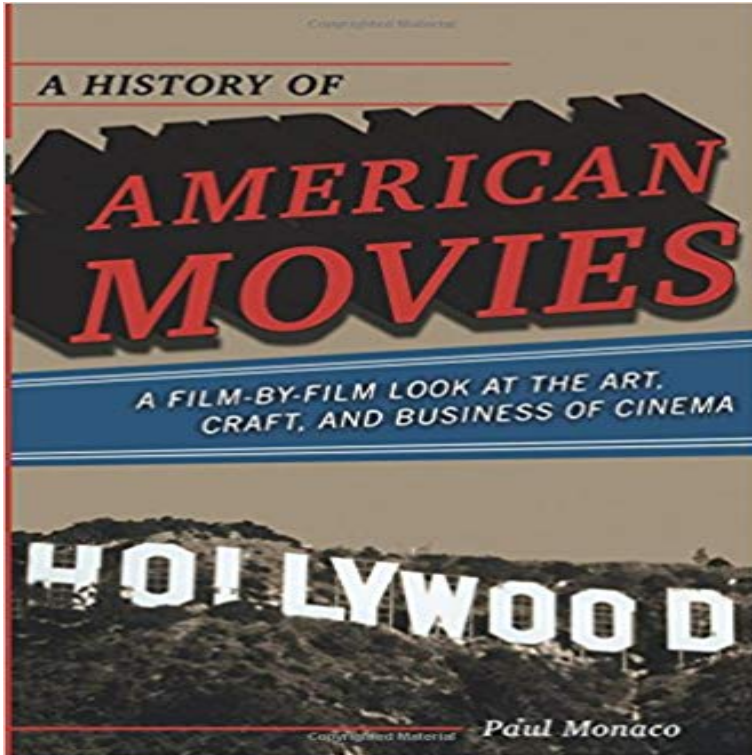


A History of American Movies: A Film-by-Film Look at the Art, Craft, and Business of Cinema
