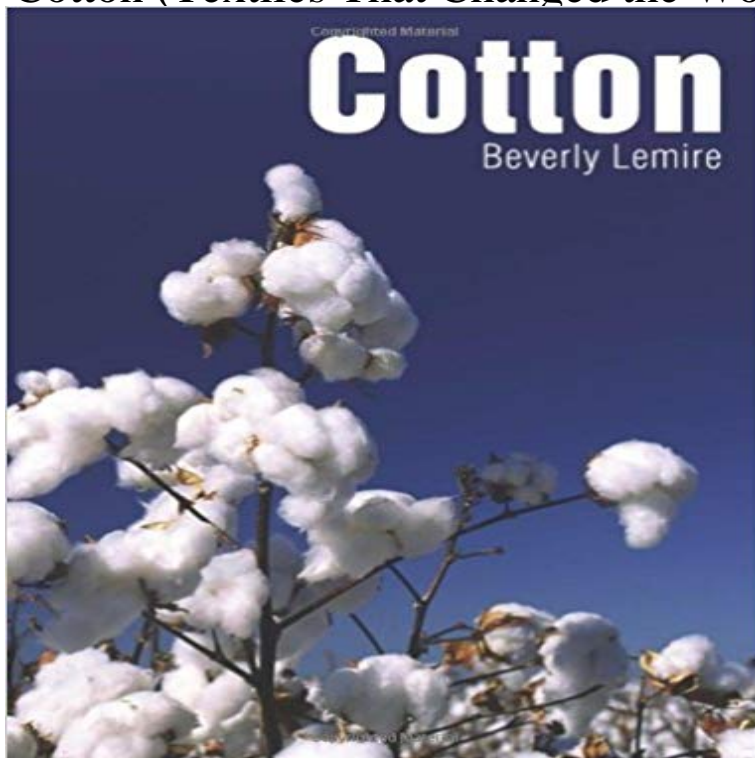


## Cotton (Textiles That Changed the World)
