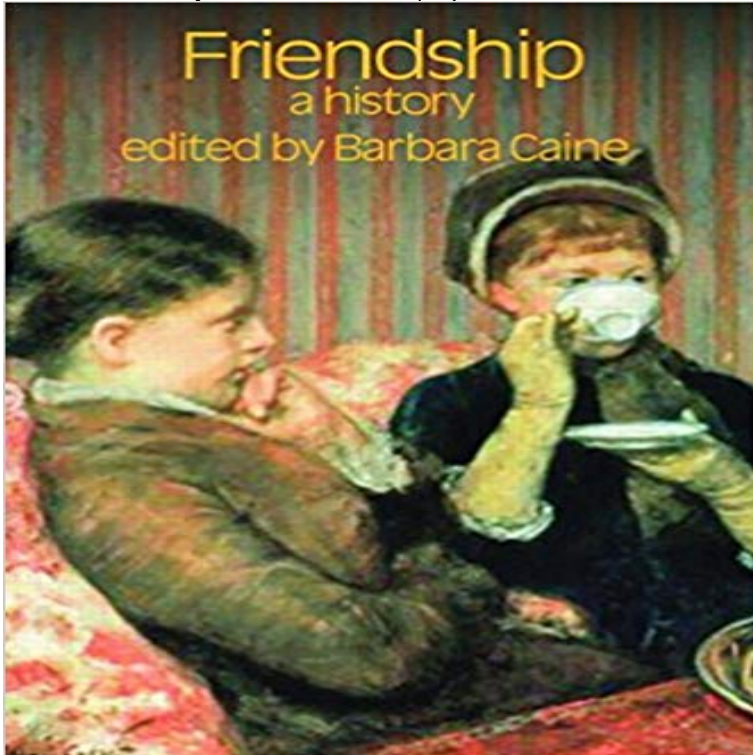


Friendship: A History (Critical Histories of Subjectivity and Culture)
