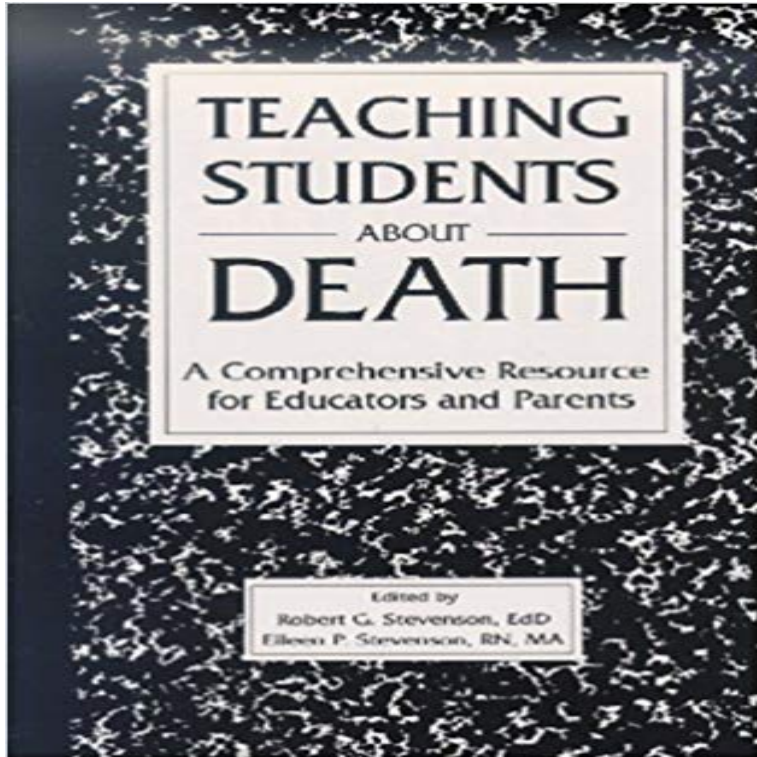


# Teaching Students About Death: A Comprehensive Resource for Educators and Parents
