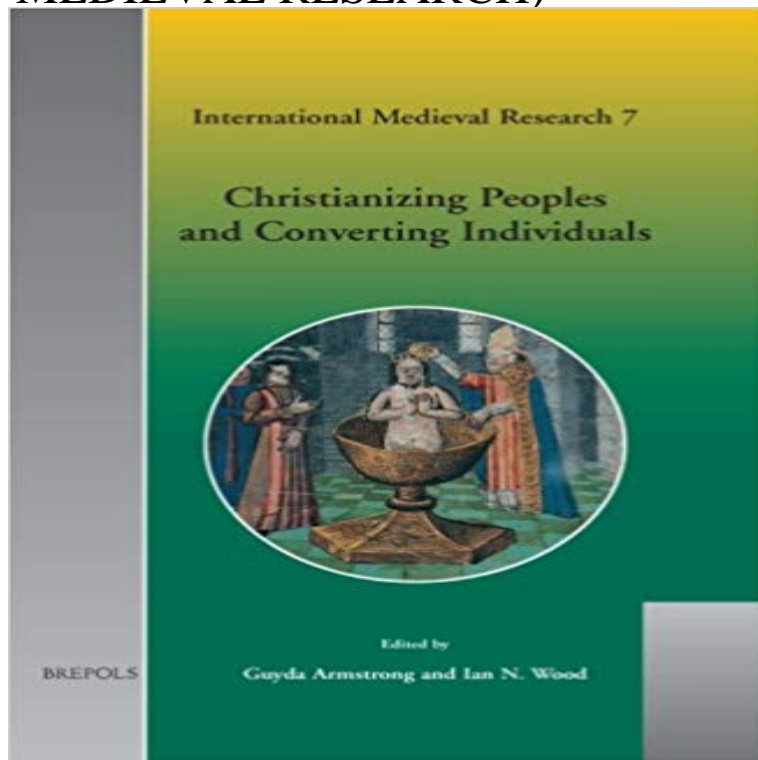


Christianizing Peoples and Converting Individuals (INTERNATIONAL MEDIEVAL RESEARCH)
