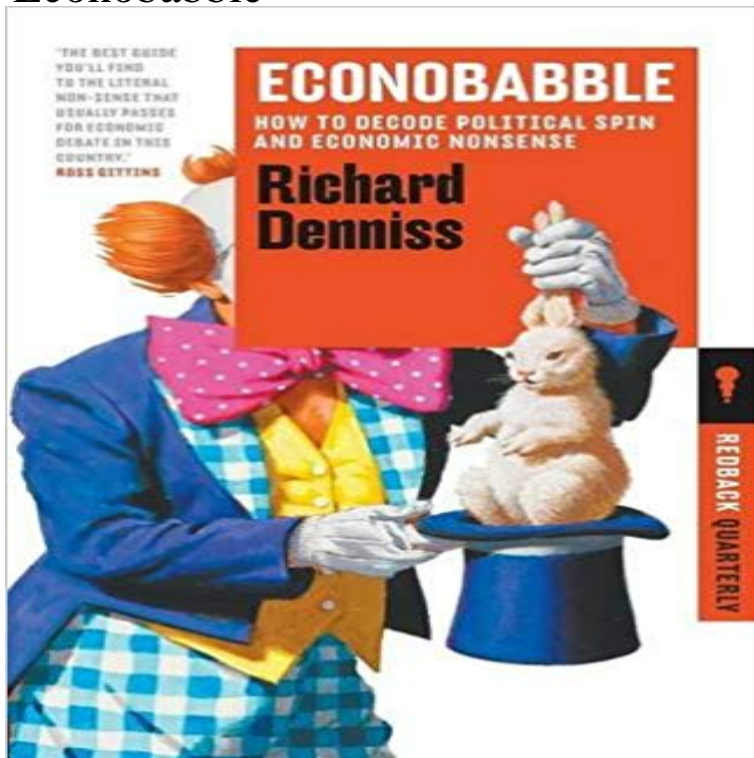


Econobabble
