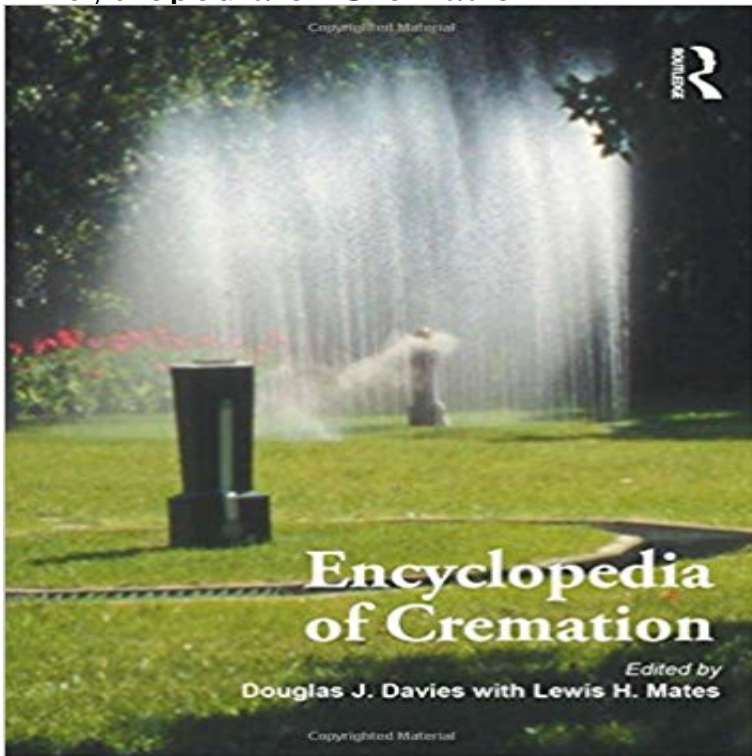


Encyclopedia of Cremation
