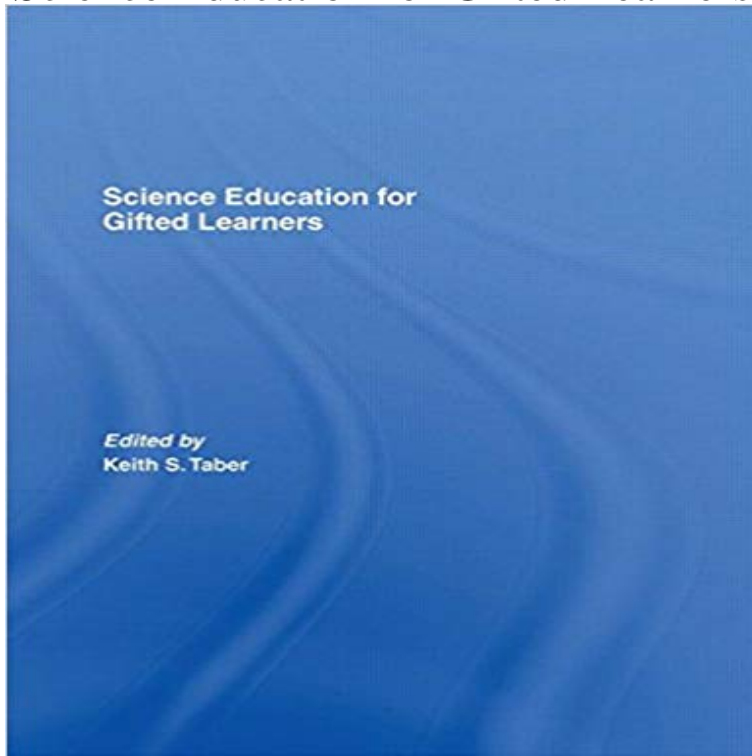


Science Education for Gifted Learners
