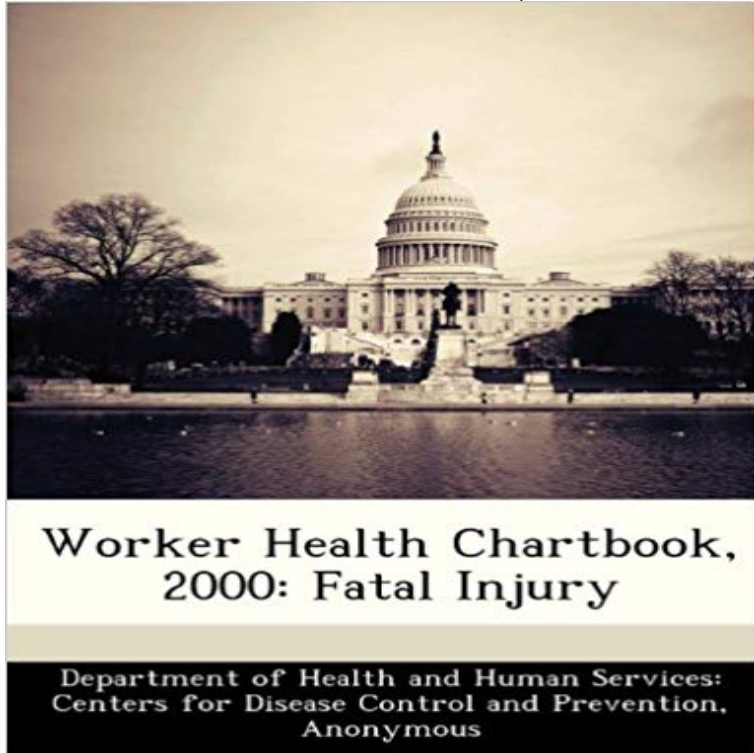


Worker Health Chartbook, 2000: Fatal Injury
