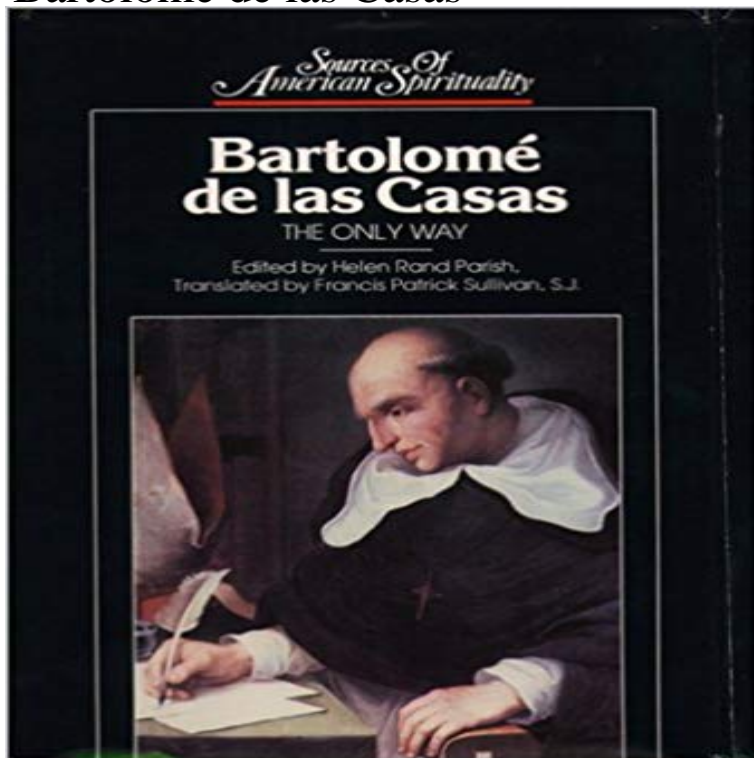


Bartolome de las Casas
