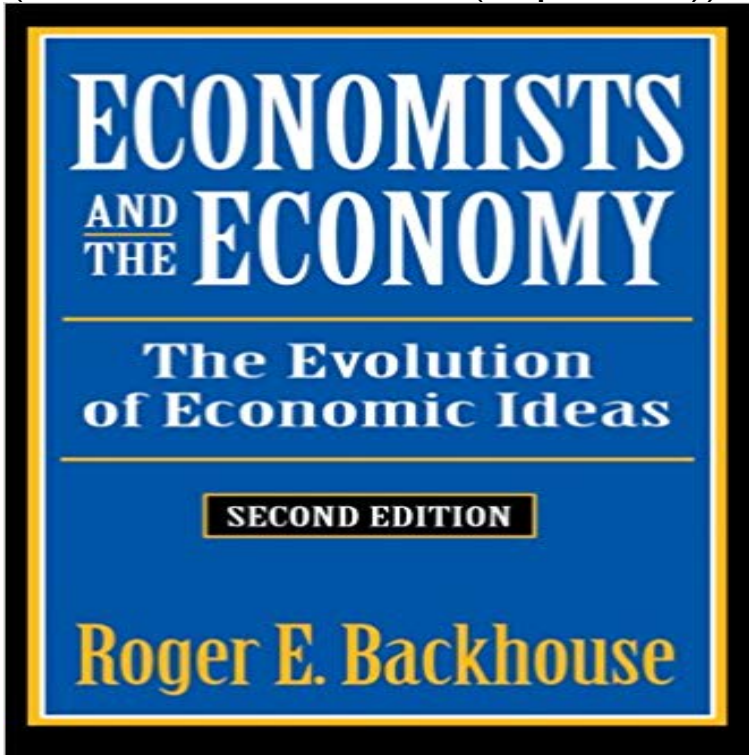


Economists and the Economy: The Evolution of Economic Ideas (Classics in Economics (Paperback))
