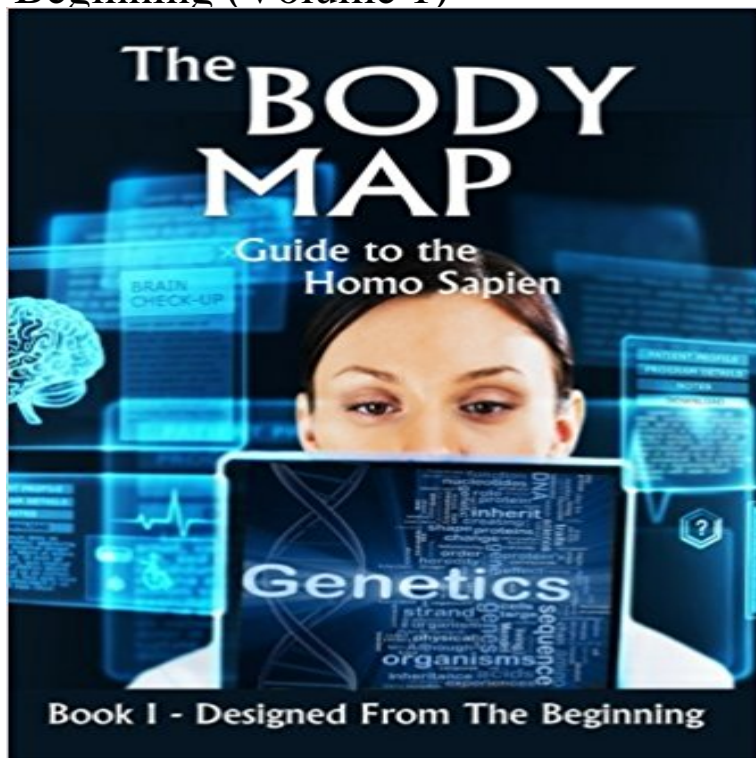


The Body Map - Guide to the Homo Sapien: Designed From The Beginning (Volume 1)
