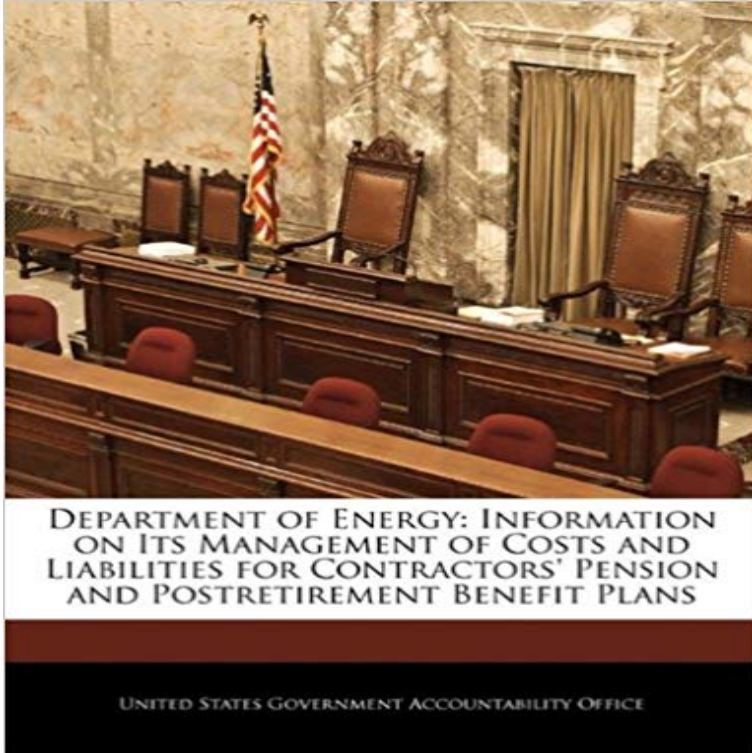


Department of Energy: Information on Its Management of Costs and Liabilities for Contractors Pension and Postretirement Benefit Plans
