
Insomnia; and Other Disorders of Sleep by Henry M. Lyman

How wonderful is Death death, and his brother. Sleep!exclaims Shelley, echoing marvellous strains that have come down to us from the days of Homer and Hesiod. In that venerable literature Sleep and Death are represented as twin brothers, sons of Night; dwelling in the lower world of

spirits, whence they come forth to perform the will of the Olympian Gods. The prosaic genius of our scientific generation no longer tolerates such lively exercise of the imagination. The splendid anthropomorphism of the Hebrew poet, looking out upon the silent night, and cheering his soul with the sonorous exclamation, Behold, he that keepeth Israel Shall neither slumber nor sleep ...
