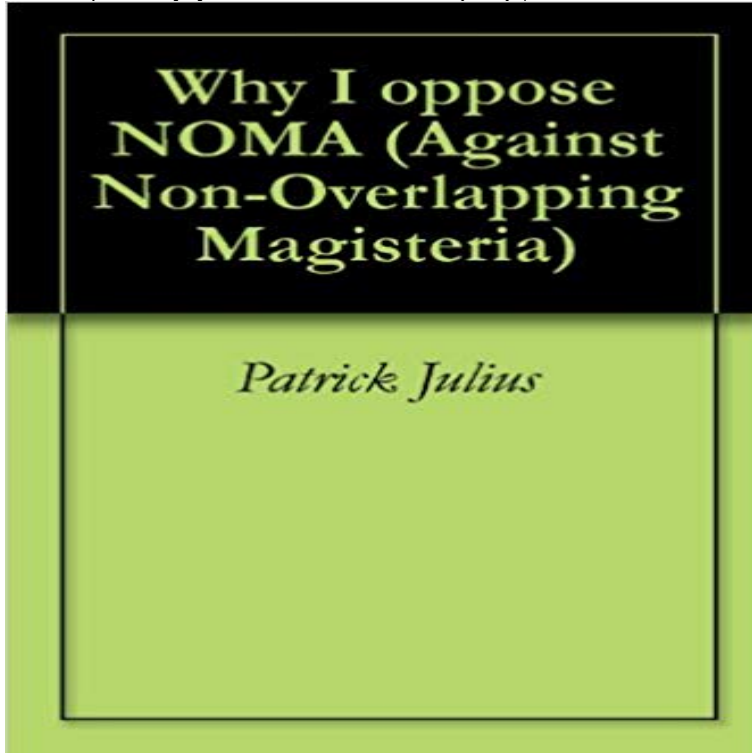


Why I oppose NOMA (Against Non-Overlapping Magisteria Book 1)
