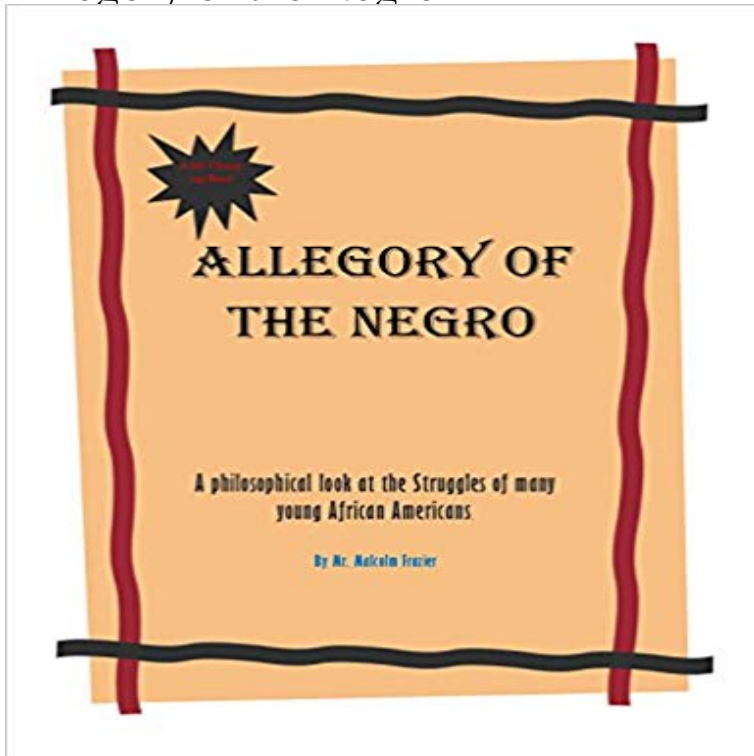


Allegory of the Negro
