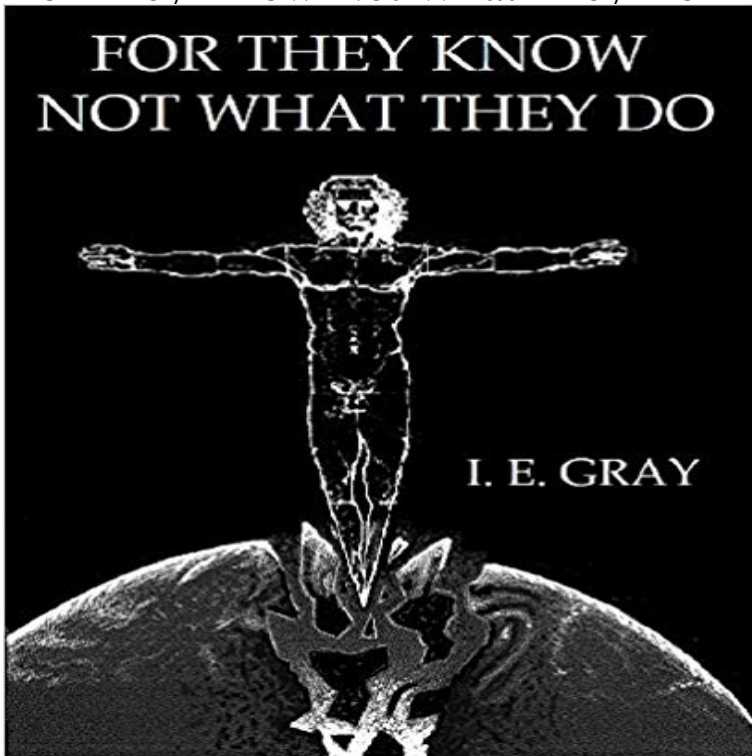


For They Know Not What They Do
