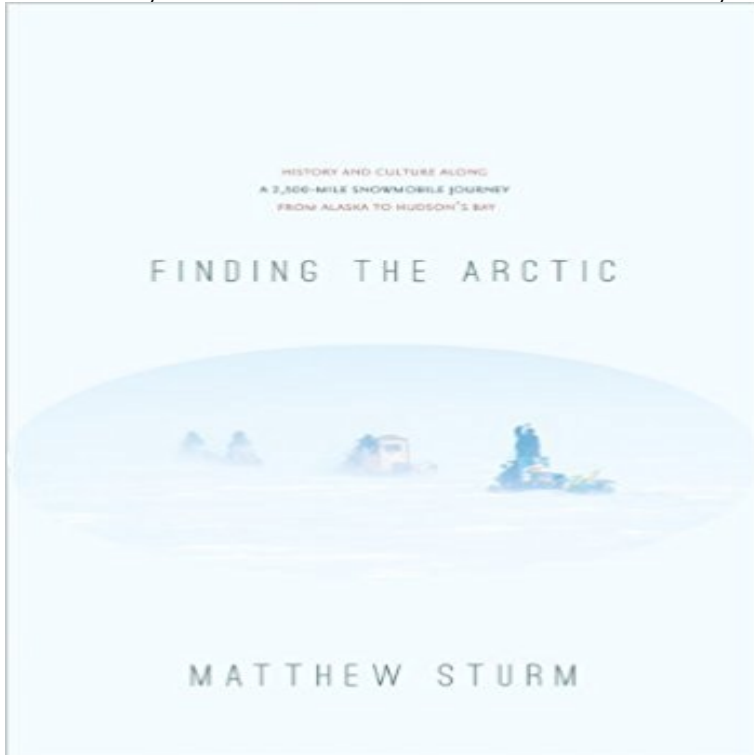


Finding the Arctic: History and Culture Along a 2,500-Mile Snowmobile Journey from Alaska to Hudsons Bay
