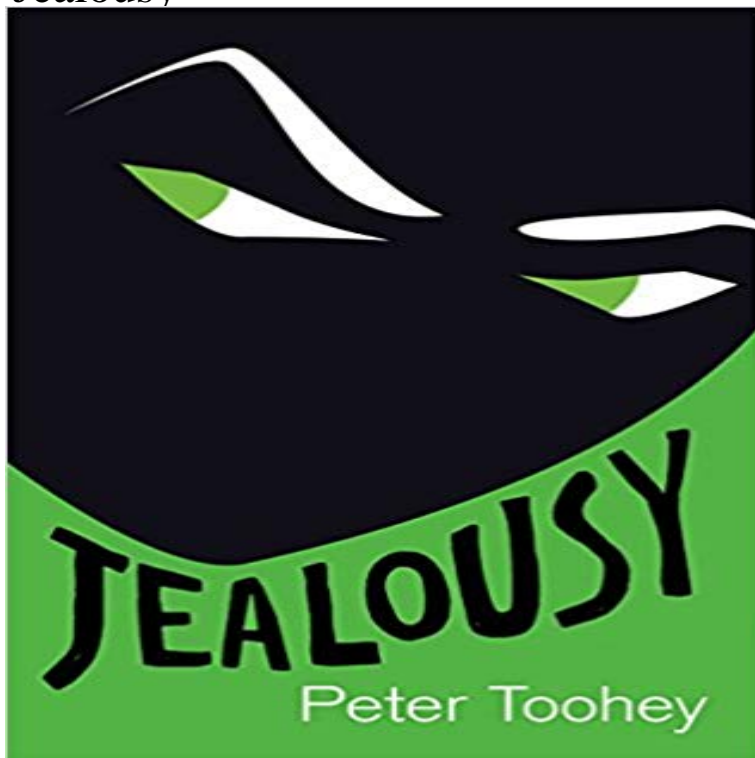


Jealousy
